



Grade: Kindergarten

Subject: Math

Expectation(s): Can draw, sort and classify basic shapes

Materials needed: Shape bingo cards (attached); or paper, crayons/markers to make your own shape bingo cards; small objects (coins, beans, etc.) to mark the shape bingo cards; a hat or bag for drawing the shapes; scissors; crayons/markers to color the shapes on the bingo cards (optional)

Lesson Description: Play shape bingo with your student. Explain the rules of the game – the ‘caller’ will randomly choose a shape and each player can mark that shape once on their card. The first player to get four in a row wins.

Have your student identify and name all the shapes on the bingo cards (circle, square, rectangle, star, triangle). If they’d like, have them color the shapes in to decorate their card. Alternatively, you could decide to create new cards and draw your own shapes, allowing your student to practice drawing shapes.

















Cut out the shapes on the final page; place them in a hat or bag or simply put them facedown on a table and shuffle them around.

Have your student play the role of ‘caller’; they will pick a slip of paper and call out the name of the shape.

































- Ask your student to explain what their choices are after each shape is drawn – because there are multiple examples of each shape on the cards, they will have a choice of which one to cover. Help them identify all their options if they aren’t able to on their own.
- Have fun – the goal of this game is simply for your student to be able to confidently recognize and name the shapes on their bingo card.
